The **Women Transitioning to Trades & Employment (WTTE) Program** will provide a full time academic upgrading and career exploration program, offering Grade 12 equivalent credits in Math and Communications for women and gender non-conforming people who are:

- Looking for stable employment
- Interested in non-traditional work
- Able to commit to a full-time training/education program

Through its very focused and supported delivery model, WTTE will prepare low-income women and gender non-conforming people who have experienced and/or are at risk of intimate partner violence for success in post-secondary and apprenticeship training programs in many sectors.

We know that although the trades offer well-paying jobs and flexible employment opportunities, women and gender non-conforming people are underrepresented in them. Together with the strong support of our project partners, this program is designed to increase the number of marginalized women and gender non-conforming people entering and being successful in the trades.

Eligible applicants will:

- ✓ Have a minimum Grade 10 education or Canadian Benchmark Level 8 English skills
- ✓ Be living on a low income, including those on OW or ODSP
- ✓ Be women, gender non-conforming or two-spirited people from all cultural backgrounds, who have faced partner violence or are at risk of partner violence
- ✓ Be able to attend full-time college in downtown Toronto
- ✓ Have connections to supports and services in the community

EVERYONE WHO APPLIES TO THE PROGRAM WILL BE INVITED TO ATTEND A GROUP INTERVIEW AND TO COMPLETE AN ENGLISH SKILLS ASSESSMENT.

You do not need to screen potential applicants – we will conduct the interview and application process and conduct some assessment activities that will help people to decide if this program is for them.
